MR. KAY

Met with new resident on Randon who emailed us with concerns about flooding at the house they just bought. The property has a private cistern and I showed him how to isolate it from the storm water pipe to eliminate the possibly of flooding from the storm water system.

The Donavon house on Randon goes up for final auction on May 29, 2019. Spoke with a resident who had called about the condition and gave her the information about the auction. She has someone who wants to bid on it.

The Ferguson house on Villamar has now entered the court system for the tax foreclosure. Karen Ferguson has moved to Pennsylvania and she signed for the certified mail. She came back to Toledo and started to clean up the property and said she is going to sell it. The taxes are still not paid and the foreclosure continues. Received complaints about Doug Whiting letting his 5 dogs out the back gate, onto the softball field, and not picking up after them. Texted him about it and after checking with Mr. McIntosh found that the back fence and gates belong to the park so we locked the gate preventing him from using that gate.

Spoke to a resident who called about the car break-ins. He had seen a group of males walking the neighborhood looking in cars. The police had stopped the group at the park and identified them and wrote up a report. No arrests were made as they did not catch them in the act and they had nothing with them.

Spoke to resident on Shoreland about a sink hole in their yard that had been there for a while. The storm water pipe was exposed and showed no sign of damage so we filled the hole with sand to make it safe and will monitor the site to see if it continues to settle. Checked on the flooding situation at the end of Shoreland and observed that the flood waters are not coming from the storm drains. It is coming from Michigan first and floods over the storm drains. It also comes over the wall in the area of Ted LaCourse's house first.

Spoke to the Lucas County garage regarding sink hole on Shoreland near Holliday, they are going to make repairs once the Ottawa River recedes.

The old Anderson's residence, 3072 Shoreland had 8 foot of water in the basement and new owner pumped it and flooded adjacent properties.

Crack sealing will be starting week of May 30, 2019. Weather permitting.

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Garbage truck had some trash fall out of their truck going down Suder Avenue. Had to spend most of morning picking trash up. Truck did not have the gate locked.
