- Took calls related to cars parked opposite ways – let Chris know and let residents know to report them to Chris – use the online tool
- Watched ribbon cutting for the new school – was not able to attend
- 4/21/21 –Reviewed and signed payroll checks and worked with Shelly on the 941 reports
- Spoke to a resident about the house on 2727 Shoreland and the construction project that has not been finished for years – referred it to Jim
- Discuss – blight clean up – use our crew but charge to general fund or do we need to contract out (Bryon)
- Working with Bryon on a timeline and schedule for the Villamar Project – this will start when Bryon get back from vacation
 - Step 1- brush removal
 - Step 2- parking lot
 - Step 3- Order picnic tables, benches, and grills
 - Step 4- Put up the donated bird houses and bat houses
 - Step 5- Add items from step 3
 - Continue to look at grants and sponsors for playground equipment and pavilion
 - Waiting to hear on grant for plants and trees
- Working on insurance quote with RJ from Savage – we spoke a couple weeks ago and it was around 22% higher – asked him to go back because that is extremely high – Have a call with RJ Monday to discuss further. Will update at the board meeting.
