ZONING Procedures

Day 1- Blight reported

Day 2 or 3 - Zoning inspector check if blight still exists

Day 4 - Issue 7 day Zoning violation

Day 12 - Zoning inspector checks if blight still exists

Board to issue a nuisance resolution. Resolution is sent certified. The resident/owner has 7 days after the certified letter is received to correct the issue. If the issue is not corrected the township will clean it up and add the charges to the owners property taxes.

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
